




WHAT IS PRO-STRIDE?

Experiencing Joint Lameness

Pro-Stride APS is an innovative device in which the output produces a concentrated solution of cells, platelets, growth factors, and antiinflammatory proteins (including IL-1ra and other anabolic proteins).¹

Using the patient's own blood, the Pro-Stride APS device separates and concentrates (in under 20 minutes of processing), allowing for administering of the output in a single visit.²





BENEFITS

- All-natural (from horse's own blood)
- Convenient (no incubation, < 20 minute processing, ambulatory)
- Clinically demonstrated effectiveness ²⁻⁵



THE PRO-STRIDE DIFFERENCE

The Pro-Stride APS device processes the horses own blood at the point-of-care by first isolating platelets and white blood cells in a small volume of plasma then further concentrating these components with desiccating beads.


There are several naturally occurring inhibitors (anti-inflammatory proteins) of the pro-inflammatory cytokines IL-1 and TNF-alpha. These include IRAP / IL-1ra, sIL-1R, and sTNF-R. All of these are highly concentrated within Pro-Stride APS.

- Pro-Stride APS's output is neither PRP nor an autologous conditioned serum (ACS)
- Pro-Stride's output does not require an incubation period
- Pro-Stride's output is never frozen








Relative Proportion of Cells and Proteins in Blood, L-PRP and Pro-Stride APS
